

Shooting Assignment: Motion

For this assignment, you will have to shoot three things: Motion Blur, Moving Water Motion Blur, and Panning.

Motion Blur: You need a person or thing that's moving. **USE A TRIPOD!!** Depending on the light available, your light meter, and your f/stop, you should use a slow shutter speed. Adjust your settings according to your light meter though!!

Moving Water Motion Blur: This will be shot similar to the regular motion blur. You need to find a *safe* spot close to a river where the water is moving over rocks or ledges (whitewater). Get as close as is safe. Use the highest f/number (usually f/22 depending on the camera) and adjust your shutter speed until it is at the speed that your light meter likes. **USE A TRIPOD!!**

Panning: Your subject needs to be moving from left to right or right to left of you – not towards or away from you. Use a slow shutter speed (between 1 and 8) and adjust your f/stop accordingly. When the shutter is open, move your camera to keep the subject in the same spot in the frame. In other words, follow the subject with your camera. A tripod is not necessary, but you may use one with the left to right adjustment loosened.
